- The first half of the scholarship will be sent directly to Northwest Lineman College to be applied to the student's account. The second half will be reimbursed directly to the student after confirmation of graduate status. Acceptance of this scholarship does not alter the enrollment agreement terms and conditions between Northwest Lineman College and student.
- We ask that the scholarship recipient allow Great Lakes Energy an opportunity to consider him/her for employment. Acceptance of the scholarship does not obligate either Great Lakes Energy or the scholarship recipient employment with Great Lakes Energy upon completion of the 15-week program.
